

Preserving Our Values

WHEREAS the Georgia Republican Party has a long tradition of strong support for traditional family values including Right to Life for all Georgian from fertilization to natural death; Marriage as between only a man and a woman, and 2nd amendment rights for an individual's right to self defense to name a few;

BE IT THEREFOR RESOLVED this May 16th, 2009 that the Georgia State Republican Party Convention do hereby reaffirm our support for families and values as presented in the National Republican Party Platform and call for support for a human life amendment to the Georgia Constitution and endorsees making clear that the protections under the Fourteenth Amendment of the United States Constitution apply to unborn children and

BE IT THEREFOR RESOLVED that since the 14th Amendment guarantees all citizens equal protection under the law and that since hate crimes legislation elevates some victims of violent crimes over others, we the Republican Party of Georgia oppose the passage of any Hate Crimes legislation, and we call upon the Congress of the United States of America to oppose such legislation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the authority claimed by the United Nations Committee on the Rights of the Child represents a direct affront to fundamental parental rights and the Georgia Republican Party opposes the ratification of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child and call on the Congress of the United States and its many states propose and ratify an amendment to the US Constitution preserving the liberty of parents to direct the upbringing and education of their children as a fundamental right;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be forwarded to the President of the United States, the Speaker of the US House of Representatives, the President of the US Senate, the Governor of Georgia, each member of Georgia's congressional delegation, and each member of the Georgia General Assembly.
